LATE FEES* A late entry fee of \$20 will be charged for entries submitted after the closing date.

REFUNDS Refunds upon withdrawal are at the discretion of the GFSC committee and will only be on provision of a medical certificate. An administration fee of \$10.00 may be deducted at the discretion of the GFSC Committee

ELIGIBILITY Kiwi Skate entrants must have been enrolled in a Paradise Skate School Class or other Kiwi Skate class in 2011 or 2012 and have completed a minimum of Kiwi Skate Novice 1 badge level, with the exception of the Skate School Character division for which there are no specific requirements.

NZIFSA Grade entrants must hold a current NZIFSA Test and Competition (TC) registration at the close of entries date.

GENERAL COMPETITION REGULATIONS:

All NZIFSA grades will be conducted in accordance with the NZIFSA Rules and Regulations for 2012 for programme requirements by grade. These can be viewed on the NZIFSA website www.nzifsa.org.nz, see; Rules & Regulations, Competitions (200) section

NZIFSA Test requirements apply at the time of the draw. Skaters will not be permitted to skate in a grade for which they do not hold the required tests	
Information on eligibility by grade	Rule 227
Short programme requirements (Novice to Senior only)	Rule 229.1
Free Programme requirements Pre-Elementary and Elementary	Rule 229.3
Free Programme requirements Juvenile to Senior	Rule 229.2
Free Programme requirements Adult	Rule 229.4

For all grades up to and including Juvenile entries may be divided by age depending on the number of entries received. Similarly there may be separate adult Kiwi Skate grades.

COMPETITION MUSIC

All competitors shall provide music on compact disc only. (coaches to provide Kiwi Skate entrants music). Each CD must contain only one track and must be marked with competitors name, grade entered and the exact running time of music. Please hand a copy of your music in to a committee member no later than Friday 13th July

PLANNED PROGRAMME CONTENT SHEETS

For all NZIFSA grade events current PPC's are required to validate your entry. Please ensure your PPC is updated on NZIFSA website <http://www.nzifsa.org.nz/members/mynzifsa/ppc.php> by draw date (4th July 2012) Entries will not be accepted if PPC is not updated or verified.

CALCULATION OF RESULTS

All grades will be judged under the IJS system with the exception that closed marking will apply to Kiwi skate grades.

SCHEDULING:

The Schedule for the competition will be posted on the NZIFSA website after the draw date. For various reasons the competition schedule may change up to and including the day of the competition. Check your email or updates posted on the NZIFSA or Glenburn web site

While the every effort will be made to ensure this event takes place as planned, the organisers accept no responsibility for losses or inconvenience associated with any alterations or changes to the planned schedule. The competition may run up to 30 minutes early of the latest schedule, please ensure you plan your journey so as to allow time to deal with any contingencies.

VIDEO RECORDING AND PHOTOGRAPHY:

Individuals wishing to use video cameras will be required to request permission in the form of a Video Permit prior to the competition. Holders of a video permit will be limited to recording the performance only of the skater for which the permit is granted. Persons who wish to video other skaters must obtain written permission from the skater(s) concerned, or in the case of minors, their parents or guardians. Otherwise, video recording is prohibited. The use of FLASH photography or VIDEO-LIGHTS are not permitted during warm-ups or events.
