NON CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: KIWISKATE		
Kiwiskaters do NOT require to be a member of the Dunedin Ice Skating Club		
	Tiny Tots: (6yrs & Under)	Skate the width of the rink Backward marching Squat down while moving
	Beginner	Stopping on both feet Backward skating Squat for four counts whilst moving
	Elementary	Forward bubbles for the width of the ice rink T pushes on both feet Glide on one foot for four counts per foot
	Basic	Forward pumping on a figure eight pattern Two foot turn forward to backwards in both directions Six forward inside edges down the line
	Novice 1	Backward one foot glide for four counts per foot Backward pumping on a figure eight pattern Forward inside three turn (skater may choose which foot)
	Novice 2	Forward inside Mohawk (skater may choose which foot) Forward outside three turn (skater may choose which foot) Spiral on a curve around half a ice hockey circle
	Advanced	Six backward outside edges Backward three turns (skater may choose inside or outside edges) Forward three turn into back outside edge
	Proficiency	Backward inside edges down a line Backward crossovers on a figure eight pattern Made up Kiwi Skate step sequence of skaters choice
	Freeskate	Programme with music (1 minute and 20 seconds) must include; Bunny Hop Two foot spin One foot glide Backwards bubbles (minimum three) Squat while moving for four counts
	Freestyle (Kiwiskate grade)	Programme with music (1 minute and 40 seconds) must include; Salchow jump Toeloop jump Optional jump (can be a combination jump) One foot spin (minimum 3 revolutions) Step sequence (at least one half of the rink length) with a fixed base value and evaluated on GOE only.
	Solo Dance	Dutch Waltz

NON CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: SYNCHRONISED	
Kiwiskate	Team of minimum 6 skaters. Programme up to 2 mins (+/- 10 secs)
Adult	A team of 9 – 16 skaters. Programme 30 mins (+/- 30 secs)

NON CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: INTERPRETATIVE TEAM		
Age Groups	5 – 11 years	Must have at least two, and no more than four skaters. Vocal music is allowed. Props are allowed, but must not be left on the ice. Programme up to 2 mins (+/- 10 secs)

	Copper (first timers)	First Timers Forward Perimeter Stroking – 1 circuit of rink with Crossovers at each end Forward Inside Prelim Edges - full width of rink Patterns Test 0 Elementary
	Platinum	Forward Perimeter stroking 1 circuit around rink perimeter with crossovers at each end. Backward Perimeter Stroking 1 circuit around rink perimeter with crossovers at each end. Forward Outside Prelim Edges – full length of rink Pattern: Test 0 Elementary
	Pewter	Forward Perimeter Power Crossover (Russian) Stroking 1 circuit around rink perimeter with crossovers at each end. Backward Perimeter Power Crossover (Russian Stroking) 1 circuit around rink perimeter with crossovers at each end. Patterns: Test 2 Inter-Bronze Forward Power 3's (Left or Right Foot) – ½ length of rink Pattern: Test 1 Preliminary
	Bronze	Five step Mohawk Sequence – 1 circuit Forward & Backward Free-skating Cross Strokes 1 length Forward & 1 length Backward Eight step Mohawk Sequence – 2 circles (can be same or opposite direction) Patterns: Test 3 Bronze
	Silver	Backward Perimeter Power Stroking + Backward Power 3 Turns Backward Double 3 Turns – 1 length of rink Inside Slide Chasse – 1 circuit Pattern: Test 4 Inter Silver
	Gold	Forward Perimeter Power Stroking Backward Quick Rocker turn Sequence Spiral Sequence (Silver Test) Patterns: Test 5 Silver Straight Line Choctaw Sequence Pattern: Test 6 Inter Gold

Freeskating	Grade	Test requirements Rule 227.1 applies
	Pre-Elementary	May <u>not</u> hold any freeskating medals but <u>may</u> hold Elementary Stroking but no higher.
	Elementary	Must hold Elementary Free Skating but no higher free skating test and a minimum of Elementary Stroking but no higher than Preliminary Stroking
	Juvenile	Minimum test passes – Preliminary Free Skating & Preliminary Stroking. Must not have reached the age of 18 before 1 st July
	Pre-Primary	Minimum test passes – Inter Bronze Free Skating & Inter Bronze Stroking. Must not have reached the age of 18 before 1 st July
	Primary	Minimum test passes – Bronze Free Skating & Bronze Stroking. Must not have reached the age of 14 before 1 st July
	Intermediate	Minimum test passes – Bronze Free Skating & Bronze Stroking
	Novice	Minimum test passes – Inter Silver Free Skating or Novice Competitive test, & Inter Silver Stroking
	Junior	Minimum test passes – Silver Free Skating or Junior Competitive test, & Silver Stroking
	Senior	Minimum test passes – Inter Gold Free Skating or Senior Competitive test, & Inter Gold Stroking

Partner Dance	Pre-Elementary	Skaters <u>must not</u> hold any NZIFSA Dance medals Pattern dances: Grp 3: Canasta Tango, Rhythm Blues (Both to be skated)
	Elementary	At least one skater must have passed Elementary Pattern Dance and either or both skaters may hold higher Pattern dances: Grp 3; Baby Blues, Swing Dance (Both to be skated)
	Juvenile	Minimum test passes - Both skaters must have Preliminary Dance Pattern dances: Grp 3: Golden Skaters' Waltz, Ten Fox plus Free Dance
	Pre-Primary	Minimum test passes – Both skaters must have Inter Bronze Dance Pattern dances: Grp 2: Foxtrot, American Waltz plus Free Dance
	Primary	Minimum test passes - Both skaters must have Bronze Dance Pattern dances: Grp 2: Foxtrot, American Waltz plus Free Dance
	Novice	Minimum test passes – Both skaters must have Bronze Dance and at least one skater must hold Intersilver Dance or Novice Competitive Dance Pattern dances: Grp 1: European Waltz, Tango; Grp 2: Rocker Foxtrot, Starlight Waltz (one group to be drawn) plus Free Dance
	Junior	Minimum test passes – Both skaters must have Inter-Silver Dance and at least one skater must hold Silver Dance or Junior Competitive Dance. Short Dance plus Free Dance
	Senior	Minimum test passes – Both skaters must have Silver Dance and at least one skater must hold Inter-Gold Dance or Senior Competitive Dance. Short Dance plus Free Dance
Solo Dance	Pre-Elementary	Skaters <u>must not</u> hold any NZIFSA Dance medals Pattern dances: Grp 3: Canasta Tango, Rhythm Blues (Both to be skated)
	Elementary	Minimum test passes - Elementary Dance. Pattern dances: Grp 3; Rhythm Blues, Swing Dance (Both to be skated)
	Juvenile	Minimum test passes - Preliminary Dance Pattern dances: Grp 3; Golden Skaters' Waltz, Baby Blues (Both to be skated)
	Pre-Primary	Minimum test passes - Interbronze Dance Pattern dances: Grp 3; Hickory Hoedown, Fourteenstep (Both to be skated)
	Primary	Minimum test passes - Bronze Dance. Pattern dances: Grp 3; Foxtrot, Tango (Both to be skated)
	Open	Minimum test passes - Intersilver Dance Pattern dances: Grp 3; Kilian, Westminster Waltz (Both to be skated)

CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: PAIRS	
Skaters are required to hold a 2014 T/C registration. Requirements for the following grades will be the same as the 2014 NZIFSA Rules & Regulations. Please read the rules & regulations and discuss with your coach.	
Juvenile	Minimum test passes – Preliminary Pair Skating and Preliminary Stroking
Pre-Primary	Minimum test passes – Inter-Bronze Pair Skating and Inter-Bronze Stroking
Primary	Minimum test passes – Bronze Pair Skating and Bronze Stroking
Novice	Minimum test passes – Inter-Silver Pair Skating or Novice Competitive test, and Inter-Silver Stroking
Junior	Minimum test passes – Silver Pair Skating or Junior Competitive test, and Silver Stroking
Senior	Minimum test passes – Inter-Gold Pair Skating or Senior Competitive test, and Silver Stroking

CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: SYNCHRONISED	
Skaters are required to hold a 2014 T/C registration. Requirements for the following grades will be the same as the 2014 NZIFSA Rules & Regulations. Please read the rules & regulations and discuss with your coach.	
Elementary	A team of 9 – 16 skaters. All skaters may hold Elementary Stroking or Elementary Dance, but no higher stroking or pattern dance test. No age limits
Juvenile	A team of 9 – 16 skaters. All skaters must have passed a minimum of Elementary Stroking or Elementary Dance. No age limits
Open	A team of 8 – 16 skaters All skaters must have passed a minimum of Preliminary Stroking or Preliminary Dance. No age limits
Novice	A team of 9 – 16 skaters. All skaters must have passed a minimum of Preliminary Stroking or Preliminary Dance. Age limits apply.
Junior	A team of 9 – 16 skaters. All skaters must have passed a minimum of Inter-Bronze Stroking or Inter-Bronze Dance. Age limits apply.
Senior	A team of 9– 16 skaters. All skaters must have passed a minimum of Inter-Bronze Stroking or Inter-Bronze Dance. Age limits apply.
Adult	A team of 8 – 16 skaters All skaters must have passed a minimum of Elementary Stroking or Elementary Dance. Age limits apply.
