Pre-Elementary & Elementary Grades	<ul> <li>As per NZIFSA Rule 229.3</li> <li>Free skate Programme only - Programme length up to 2 minutes 15 seconds</li> <li>If entries exceed 16 in Pre Elementary or Elementary these may also be divided according to age.</li> <li>Note: Falls in Pre Elementary &amp; Elementary grades to be deducted as a 0.50 deduction rather than a full 1.00 deduction</li> </ul>
Pre-Elementary Grade:	<ul> <li>Skaters may not hold any NZIFSA Free skating medals and may hold Elementary but no higher Stroking test.</li> <li>Optional jump (selected from Loop, Flip or Lutz)</li> <li>Salchow</li> <li>Toe loop</li> <li>One foot spin (min 3 revs)</li> <li>A Simple step sequence (at least one half the length of the rink).</li> </ul>
Elementary Grade:	<ul> <li>Skaters must hold a minimum of Elementary Free skating but no higher Free skating test and a minimum of Elementary Stroking but no higher than Preliminary Stroking.</li> <li>Salchow</li> <li>Toe loop</li> <li>One foot spin with no change of position – choice of upright/sit/camel (min 4 revs)</li> <li>Step sequence (fully utilises the ice surface).</li> <li>Optional element 1, jump different from those above</li> <li>Optional element 2, jump different from those above</li> <li>Optional Element 3, spin different from those above (can be a combination spin without a change of foot (min 4 revs).</li> <li>Note: One of the optional jump elements can be a jump combination.</li> </ul>
