- Late entries: May be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Co-ordinator. An additional fee of \$50.00 will be charged for entries accepted after the closing date, but no entries will be accepted after the draw under any circumstances.

- **Refunds:** Refund of entry fee(s) for withdrawal for medical or bereavement reasons, subject to the provision of a medical certificate. An administration fee of \$25 will be deducted from any refund.
- **Trophies:** Will be awarded to the first three places in each event regardless of the club or country they represent.

Technical Requirements & Eligibility:

All disciplines and grades as per current NZIFSA Rules & Regulations for 2014 (ISU Junior & Senior 2014/2015 rules will apply). These are posted on the NZIFSA website <u>www.nzifsa.org.nz</u> Rules & Regulations, Competitions (200 sections).

Music: Must be on CDs. All CDs must be clearly marked with the competitors name, club, grade, event, & length of music. The official competition CDs must be submitted at least one hour before competing. It is the skater's responsibility to ensure that backup copies are available within one minute in the case of technical failure.

Photography: No flash photography will be permitted as it may impact on the skater's performance.

Video Recording:

Individuals using recording devices will be required to request the permission of the competition organisers prior to the competition. Applications are on the entry form. Only people who have been granted a video permit may record only their own skater. If you wish to record other skaters then written permission must be obtained from the skater(s) concerned, if these skaters are minors, their parents or guardians must give written consent.

Seating: Parents / spectators should be seated on the stands, as per NZIFSA regulations parents are not allowed to stand by the Skaters and Coaches Only Area.
