- Competitors may compete in a maximum of 3 events plus Synchro Team/Skills event, Creative Performance & Family Partner Dance
- Where skaters have both a short and free programme there will be no separate draw, competitors will skate in reverse order to their places in the preceding segment of the competition

<u>Awards</u>: Will be presented for 1st, 2nd & 3rd places in each event at the conclusion of the competition

Judging: The International Judging System (IJS) will be used for all NZIFSA grades.

Skaters will be judged on their ability to interpret the music and develop a theme by using their skating skills.

ADULT STROKING PROGRAM

Not required to have passed any medal tests, however skaters holding tests must skate Pewter level or higher.

Stroking - Up to 4 skaters may be on ice at same time

Forward Perimeter Stroking – 1 circuit of rink with crossovers at each end
Forward Inside Prelim Edges - full width of rink
Forward stroking 1 circuit around rink perimeter with crossovers at each end.

Forward Russian Stroking 1 circuit around rink perimeter with crossovers at each end.
Backward Russian Stroking 1 circuit around rink perimeter with crossovers at each end.
Power 3's (Left or Right Foot) – ½ length of rink
Five step Mohawk Sequence – 1 circuit

PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT INFORMATION

At all competitions, competitors in every event to be scored using the IJS must submit for each program their planned program content (PPC) information (including musical selection) before close of entries. Competitors must complete either the electronic form on the NZIFSA website or submit a paper copy. Changed PPC sheets must be handed in to the Accreditation desk at the time of registration for the information of the Technical Panel. Entries will not be accepted without a completed PPC, either hard copy or electronic.

MUSIC:

All Freeskating competitors shall provide music on Compact Disk (CD). The CD must contain only one track and must be marked as follows:

- Competitors Name
- Championship Section (e.g. Primary Ladies)
- Programme Identification (e.g. Short Programme)
- Exact running time of music (not skating time)

CMFSC reserves the right to combine 2 or more grades together if only 1 entry in any grade or to change entry grade where applicable – i.e. skater holds medal tests signifying entry into another grade.
