### **CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: FREESKATING**

Skaters are required to hold a 2015 T/C registration. Requirements for the following grades will be the same as the 2015 NZIFSA Rules & Regulations. Please read the rules & regulations and discuss with your coach.

Intermediate	INTERMEDIATE Championship for Singles is open to those skaters who, at the closing of entries:  o have passed a minimum of Test 3 (Bronze) Freeskating and a minimum of Test 4 (Inter Silver) Stroking;
Novice	NOVICE Championship for Singles is open to those skaters who, at the closing of entries:  o have passed a minimum of Test 4 (Inter Silver) Free Skating or have passed the Novice Competitive Test and a minimum of Test 5 (Silver) Stroking.
Junior	JUNIOR Championship for Singles is open to those skaters who, at the closing of entries:  o have passed a minimum of Test 5 (Silver) Freeskating or have passed the Junior Competitive test and a minimum of Test 6 (Inter Gold) Stroking.
Senior	SENIOR Championship for Singles is open to those skaters who, at the closing of entries:  o have passed a minimum of Test 6 (Inter Gold) Freeskating or have passed the Senior Competitive test and a minimum of Test 7 (Gold) Stroking.

Skaters are required to hold a 2015 T/C registration. Requirements for the following grades will be the same as the 2015 NZIFSA Rules & Regulations. Please read the rules & regulations and discuss with your coach.

Silver II	<b>SILVER II</b> Championships for singles is open to those skaters who have reached the age of 35 years but not reached the age of 55 years before the 1 <sup>st</sup> of July preceding the championship.
Silver III	<b>SILVER III</b> Championship for Singles is open to those skaters who have reached the age of 55 years or more before the 1 <sup>st</sup> July preceding the Championships.
Gold I	<b>GOLD I</b> Championships for singles is open to those skaters who reached the age of 18 years but not reached the age of 35 years before the 1 <sup>st</sup> of July preceding the championship.
Gold II	<b>GOLD II</b> Championships for singles is open to those skaters who have reached the age of 35 years but not reached the age of 55 years before the 1 <sup>st</sup> of July preceding the championship.
Gold III	<b>GOLD III</b> Championship for Singles is open to those skaters who have reached the age of 55 years or more before the 1 <sup>st</sup> July preceding the Championships.

At least 75% of the skaters must have reached the age of 14 years bfore the 1 <sup>st</sup> of July immediately preceding the date of any competition they enter.
