2015 GLENBURN FIGURE SKATING CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

This competition is a NZ Nationals qualifying event.

DATES: Saturday 30 May 4.15pm - 8.15pm and Monday 1 June 4.15pm to 7.45pm (no competition events on Sunday 31 June) Note: Skate School (Kiwi Skate) Grades will be on Saturday 30 May

VENUE: Paradice Ice Rink, Lansford Crescent, Avondale. www.paradice.co.nz

ENTRIES CLOSE: Saturday 16 May. Late entries will be subject to an additional fee*

DRAW: Saturday 23 May 8.45am - Paradice Ice Rink - Avondale.

No entries accepted after the draw.

ENTRIES: Entries must be made on an official entry form and will only be accepted on payment of the appropriate fee. (Note that there are separate entry forms for NZIFSA grades and Kiwi Skate entrants)

- LATE FEES* A late entry fee of \$20 for NZIFSA grade skaters and \$5 for Kiwi skate will be charged for any entries accepted after the closing date.
- **REFUNDS** Refunds upon withdrawal are at the discretion of the GFSC committee and will <u>only</u> be on provision of a medical certificate. An administration charge of 25% of the entry fee will be deducted.

Announcement Glenburn Club Championships 2015- cont

ELIGIBILITY Skate School entrants must have been enrolled in a Paradice Skate School Class or other Kiwi Skate class in the previous 24 months and have completed a minimum of Kiwi Skate Basic badge level, with the exception of the Skate School Character division for which there are no specific requirements.

NZIFSA Grade entrants must be a member of an NZIFSA affiliated club and hold a current NZIFSA Test and Competition (TC) registration at the close of entries date. Online PPC's must be current.

GENERAL COMPETITION REGULATIONS:

All NZIFSA grades will be conducted in accordance with the NZIFSA Rules and Regulations for 2015 for programme requirements by grade. These can be viewed on the NZIFSA website <u>www.nzifsa.org.nz</u>, see; Rules & Regulations, Competitions (200) section and Synchronised Skating (600)

NZIFSA Test requirements apply at the close of entries. Skaters will not be permitted to skate in a grade for which they do not hold the required tests

For all grades up to and including Juvenile, entries may be divided by age depending on the number of entries received.

COMPETITION MUSIC

All competitors shall provide music on compact disc only (coaches to provide Kiwi Skate entrants' music if a common piece of music is used for a class). Each CD must contain only one track and must be marked with competitors name, grade entered and the exact <u>running time</u> (ie not skating time) of the track. Music may be handed to a committee member following the close of entries or handed in at the registration desk not later than 30 mins prior to the announced warmup time for the skaters grade.

PLANNED PROGRAMME CONTENT (PPC)

For all NZIFSA grade events, current PPC's are required to validate your entry. Please ensure your PPC is entered or current on the NZIFSA website <u>http://www.nzifsa.org.nz/members/mynzifsa/ppc.php</u> at the close of entries. Entries will not be accepted if PPC is not updated or recently verified and entry fee may be forfieted. Please ask your coach to check your online PPC for you if you have any doubt.

CALCULATION OF RESULTS

All grades will be judged under the International Skating Union Judging System (IJS) with the exception of Kiwi Skate grades which will be judged using the 6.0 system. Final results will be posted online as soon as possible at the conclusion of the competition.

SCHEDULING:

The Schedule for the competition will be posted on the NZIFSA website as soon as possible following the draw date. For various reasons the competition schedule may change up to and including the day of the competition. Check your email or updates posted on the NZIFSA or Glenburn website/Facebook page.

While the every effort will be made to ensure this event takes place as planned, the organisers accept no responsibility for losses or inconvenience associated with any alterations or changes to the planned schedule. The competition may run up to 30 minutes early or late of the most recent schedule, please ensure you plan so as to allow adequate time to deal with any contingencies.

VIDEO RECORDING AND PHOTOGRAPHY:

Individuals wishing to use video cameras will be required to sign a Video Permit log at registration. Holders of a video permit will be limited to recording the performance of the skater for whom the permit is granted. Persons who wish to video skaters other than their own children, must obtain written permission from the skater(s) concerned, or in the case of minors, their parents or guardians. Otherwise, video recording is prohibited. The use of FLASH photography or VIDEO-LIGHTS is not permitted during warm-ups or events.

TROPHIES AND AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to first (gold), second (silver) and third (bronze) place winners in each category. In addition all participants will recieve a certificate. Perpetual trophies (retained by the winner for one year and then returned) are awarded in some championship grades and for the following additional catogories: "Most Promising skater", "Best Artistic Performance", "Most Outstanding Performance"

TESTS TAKEN DURING COMPETITION

Skaters who may wish to take tests during this competition are welcome to contact the organisers in this regard. Tests, if undertaken will generally be carried out before the start of the competition on either day. Skaters in Novice, Junior or Senior who may consider having their short programme judged as a competitive test under NZIFSA rules 506.5 and 506.6 should contact the organisers for further consideration. Please note that all test applications should still be made through the skater's home club in the usual fashion in the first instance. Competitive tests taken during competion will be subject to the NZIFSA component of the test fee, though further costs will not be charged for icetime over and above the skater's entry fee for the grade.

NOTE: Entrants do not need to be financial members of GFSC however in the event that a non member wins a grade, then the trophy, if any may not be awarded. GFSC welcomes new members. Memberships received before the date of draw will be eligible.
