Specific Information for SKATE SCHOOL GRADES

Programme requirements (these are intended to be the same or closely aligned to requirements for the Paradise Skate School competitions)

<p>Kiwi Skate Novice Level</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Free Skating Programme - 1 min • Performed on 1/3 ice surface (central area) • Generally skaters working on Kiwi skate badge Novice 1 or 2 • Skaters may use music of their own choice or Paradise music. • Elements expected to be performed in the program are as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ One or two-foot spin ○ Two foot jump forward to backwards ○ Mowhawk/s ○ Forward spiral ○ Forward outside 3 turn ○ Waltz jump ○ Drag ○ Forward toe pivot 	<p>Kiwi Skate Free Level</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Free Skating Programme - up to 2 min 15 sec • Performed on full ice surface. • Generally skaters working on Freeski and Freestyle Kiwi skate badges • Skaters use music of their own choice. • Elements expected to be performed in the program are as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Toe Loop ○ Salchow ○ Spiral Sequence, minimum of 2 spirals on alternating edges, feet and direction ○ Optional jump (loop, flip, lutz or combination jump) ○ One foot upright spin and/or sit spin and/or camel spin ○ Step sequence (1/2 length of area)
<p>Kiwi Skate Advanced/Proficiency Level</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Free Skating Programme - up to 1 min 30 sec. • Performed on 1/3 ice, central area. • Generally skaters working on Kiwi skate badges Advanced and Proficiency • Skaters may use music of their own choice or Paradise music. • Elements expected to be performed in the program are as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Bunny hop ○ Waltz Jump or Salchow ○ Backwards Spiral ○ Forward spiral ○ ½ flip jump or toe loop ○ One or two foot spin ○ Step sequence 	<p>Kiwi Skate Synchronized</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Free Skating Programme - up to 3 mins • Between 6 and 16 skaters • May be performed with or without music on full ice surface. • Elements expected in the program are as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Forward or backwards horizontal line (1/2 length of rink or more) ○ Two spoke wheel (optional hold) forwards or backwards ○ Forward intersection ○ Circle formation: forward crosscuts/three turn or Mohawk/backwards crosscuts/three turn or Mohawk (optional hold). Repeat twice. ○ Step sequence in block formation or block with a change of configuration.
<p>Kiwi Skate “Character” Performed on 1/3 ice as a solo or a pair. Free Skating Programme – 1 min (+/-10sec), Music to be own choice and may contain vocals No badges need to be held. Skaters are encouraged to create their own choreography with minimal coach assistance and will be scored on their artistic interpretation and development of the musical themes rather than technical skills.</p>	

All grades below may be entered as “Under 18” or as “Adult”.

Depending on the number of entries received grades may be further split by age.

Male and female skaters compete in the same grades. Medals are awarded to the first 3 place winners.
