Music



Unofficial Practice Ice Time

A schedule, booking form and pricing has been uploaded onto the NZIFSA website under the Nationals information. Please fill it out and make your payment by **Wednesday 5 October** as per the instructions. Depending on the number of skaters that register for each session, we may need to make some minor changes as to what time some skaters have their unofficial practices. The unofficial practice schedule will be published as soon as possible after the bookings close.

Just a reminder to all skaters that as per our current Rules and Regulations, there are some restrictions regarding skating on the competition ice surface once the championships have started refer Rule 213.5. "For practice sessions during National and Adult Skating Championships, once the championships have commenced, i.e. official practices for events, competitors are not allowed to practice on the competition ice surface except on official / unofficial practices organised by the Organising Committee."

For those skaters planning to arrive a day or so earlier and skate on public sessions, please be aware that for Health & Safety reasons Alpine Ice has limits on what skaters are able to do on public sessions. They do not allow jumping, spinning, or any activity where the foot is raised off the ice (eg spirals). This clearly impacts quite a lot on what you are able to practice, but it is important that you respect these rules.



Rink Layout


No Skates or Skate Bags allowed in the Café at any time

Please note that skates and skate bags are not allowed in the Zamboni Café at any time. We have provided two changing rooms where you can get changed and put your skates on.

Getting to and from the rink

Alpine Ice Sport Centre is at 495 Brougham Street, Opawa, Christchurch. Brougham Street has two lanes each way, divided by a median island. The rink is on your left if you are heading east along Brougham Street. When you exit the rink, if you want to return along Brougham Street, turn left out of the rink (it's one way so you need to turn left anyway), then right at the traffic lights, right again (third exit) at the first round about, then a left turn at the next lights will have you back on Brougham Street heading west.

We recommend you add an extra 10 -15 minutes to your drive time as there are still roadworks all over the city that may cause delays.
