Only one week to go. How exciting! Along with a few more reminders, we have some additional information for you.

## **Extension on Banquet Ticket Orders**

We have been able to extend the date that banquet orders need to be in. Final date for orders is now Wednesday 5 October. The banquet is being held Thursday 13 October at the Woolston Club. This is a chance to celebrate success, with the announcement of the provisional lists of skaters selected to the NZIFSA Development Squad, Australian Figure Skating Championship Representatives, and International A & B Team Representatives. It's also where the NZIFSA presents special awards including the Sportsperson of the Year and Administrator of the Year awards. Tickets are \$50 per person, with children under 12 years \$35 per person. The order form is also available on the NZIFSA webpage under the Nationals information. Banquet Ticket orders are now due **Wednesday 5 October**.

## Unofficial Practice Ice Time due Wednesday 5 October

A schedule, booking form and pricing has been uploaded onto the NZIFSA website under the Nationals information. Please fill it out and make your payment by **Wednesday 5 October** as per the instructions. Depending on the number of skaters that register for each session, we may need to make some minor changes as to what time some skaters have their unofficial practices. The unofficial practice schedule will be published as soon as possible after the bookings close.

Just a reminder to all skaters that as per our current Rules and Regulations, there are some restrictions regarding skating on the competition ice surface once the championships have started refer Rule 213.5. "For practice sessions during National and Adult Skating Championships, once the championships have commenced, i.e. official practices for events, competitors are not allowed to practice on the competition ice surface except on official / unofficial practices organised by the Organising Committee."

For those skaters planning to arrive a day or so earlier and skate on public sessions, please be aware that for Health & Safety reasons Alpine Ice has limits on what skaters are able to do on public sessions. They do not allow jumping, spinning, or any activity where the foot is raised off the ice (eg spirals). This clearly impacts quite a lot on what you are able to practice, but it is important that you respect these rules.

### Video permit forms

If you want to video any portion of an event you must apply for a video permit (attached). To video skaters/teams other than your own family members, you must get the written permission of the skaters concerned, or in the case of minors, their parents/guardians. Also a reminder that the use of flash photography or video flood lights is not permitted. If you are using a phone or ipad, please check that any lights are switched off. These are very distracting to both skaters and officials.
