<p><u>SINGLES</u></p> <p>Pre Elementary & Elementary Grades</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As per NZIFSA Rule 229.3 • Free skate Programme only - Programme length up to 2 minutes 15 seconds <p>Note: <i>Falls in Pre Elementary & Elementary grades to be deducted as a 0.50 deduction rather than a full 1.00 deduction</i></p>
<p>Pre Elementary Grade:</p>	<p><i>Skaters may not hold any NZIFSA Free skating medals and must hold a minimum of Elementary Stroking but no higher than Preliminary Stroking.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Optional jump (selected from Loop, Flip or Lutz) • Salchow • Toe loop • Upright spin (min 3 revs) • A Simple step sequence (at least one half the length of the rink).
<p>Elementary Grade:</p>	<p><i>Skaters must hold a minimum of Elementary Free skating but no higher Free skating test and a minimum of Preliminary Stroking but no higher than Inter-Bronze Stroking.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Salchow • Toe loop • Spin in one position with no change of foot – choice of upright/sit/camel (min 4 revs) • Step sequence (fully utilises the ice surface). • Optional element 1, jump different from those above • Optional element 2, jump different from those above (may be a jump combination consisting of only two jumps) • Optional Element 3, spin different from those above (can be a combination spin without a change of foot (min 4 revs)

Elementary	<i>At least 1 skater must have passed Test 0 (Elementary) Pattern dance at the closing of entries and either or both skaters may hold higher (rule 231.4)</i> Rhythm Blues (3 seq) Fiesta Tango (3 seq)
Juvenile to Senior Grades	Eligibility as per NZIFSA Rule 227.5 As per NZIFSA Requirements Rule 231

<u>SOLO ICE DANCE</u>	As per NZIFSA (Rules 231.5 & 231.6) (Group 2)
Pre-Elementary	NZIFSA ice dance medals must not be held Rhythm Blues (3 seq) Dutch Waltz (3 seq)
Elementary	Must have passed Test 0 (Elementary) Pattern dance at the closing of entries but may hold higher test (rule 231.6) Rhythm Blues (3 seq) Fiesta Tango (3 seq)

Elementary	Free skate only 2 minutes +/- 10 sec <i>Minimum of 8 skaters, maximum 16 skaters, may hold Preliminary stroking or Preliminary Pattern Dance but no higher stroking or pattern dance test may be held at closing date.</i> <i>All must be TC Registered.</i> Maximum of 5 Elements chosen from: 1 Block, 1 Circle 1, Line, 1 Wheel, 1 Intersection
