Entries: Entries must be made on the official electronic entry form available online nzifsa.org.nz/enter/433. Once the online entry form is completed an invoice will be emailed to you. Current PPC's are required to validate your entry.

Late entries: May be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Co-ordinator. An additional fee of \$50.00 will be charged for entries accepted after the closing date, but no entries will be accepted after the draw under any circumstances.

Refunds: Refund of entry fee(s) will be given until 12th August 2016 (inclusive), subject to the provision of a medical certificate.

Trophies: Will be awarded to the first three places in each event regardless of the club or country they represent.

Technical Requirements & Eligibility:

All disciplines and grades as per current NZIFSA Rules & Regulations for 2016 (ISU Junior & Senior 2016/2017 rules will apply). These are posted on the NZIFSA website www.nzifsa.org.nz Rules & Regulations, Competitions (200 sections).

Music: Must be on CDs. All CDs must be clearly marked with the competitors name, club, grade, event, & length of music. The official competition CDs must be submitted at least one hour before competing. It is the skater's responsibility to ensure that backup copies are available within one minute in the case of technical failure.

Photography: No flash photography will be permitted as it may impact on the skater's performance.

Video Recording:

Individuals using recording devices will be required to request the permission of the competition organisers prior to the competition. Applications are on the entry form. Only people who have been granted a video permit may record only their own skater. If you wish to record other skaters then written permission must be obtained from the skater(s) concerned, if these skaters are minors, their parents or guardians must give written consent.

Seating: Parents / spectators should be seated on the stands, WAISC would like to ask that parents/spectators do not sit in the official marshalling area.
