Such withdrawal is permitted up to, but not including, the first day of the competition, subject to the provision of a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner.

DEVELOPMENT FUND AWARD:

An award of \$100 will be made from the NIISSA Development Fund to the most promising skater. The recipient will be selected by judges and the NIISSA committee from skaters in Juvenile grade and upward.

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

The NIISSA Ice Figure Skating Championships will be conducted in accordance with the NZIFSA Rules and Regulations for 2017. These are posted on the NZIFSA website <u>http://www.nzifsa.org.nz/rules/</u> competitions

MARKING AND TABULATION:

As per Rule 217.1, for the National Championships and for North and South Island Championships, the ISU Judging System shall be used.

SCHEDULING:

For various reasons the competition schedule may change up to and including on the day of the competition. Check your email and regularly look at the notice board at the ice rink.

The competition may run up to 30 minutes early of the latest schedule, please ensure you leave early enough to deal with any contingencies and arrive at least one hour before your scheduled time to skate. You may not receive any warning at the rink that events are running early, it is your responsibility to determine if the competition is running ahead or behind schedule and be ready to skate in your warm-up and events.

MUSIC:

All competitors shall provide music in **MP3 format.** Music should be sent to <u>niissa-music@nzifsa.org.nz</u> by date of draw. File should be labelled as follows: skater name, grade, short programme or freeskate, e.g Sarah Smith, Juvenile Ladies, Freeskate.

PROGRAMME TIMING:

For singles, pairs, synchronized, the programme timing starts from the moment the skater(s) or team begins to move or skate until arriving at a complete stop at the end of the program. For grades where the programme is designated "up to" a certain time, the music time can be less, but no more than the time stated. For freeskating programmes in singles, pairs or synchronized, competitors are allowed to finish their programme within plus or minus ten seconds of the required time. Any element started after the time allowed will be considered as omitted.

VIDEO RECORDING AND PHOTOGRAPHY:

The NIISSA retains the rights for any video recording of the Championships. Individuals using video devices will be required to request the permission of the competition organisers prior to the competition. A video permit will be issued. Only people who have a video permit may record their own skater. If you wish to record other skaters then written permission must be obtained from the skater(s) concerned, or in the case of minors, their parents or guardians. **Otherwise, video recording is prohibited**. The use of FLASH photographs or VIDEO-LIGHTS is **not permitted** during warm-ups or events.
