Kiwiskate & Juvenile grades may be divided by age if required, depending on the number of entries received. If necessary, numbers may be limited due to ice time availability. The above will be at the discretion of the organisers.

(Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the competition co-coordinator, an additional fee of \$30.00 will be charged for entries accepted after the closing date).

<u>Refunds:</u> Withdrawal of an entry is permitted before the closing of entries. After the closing of entries any skater withdrawing will not be entitled to a reimbursement of entry fees, except if the withdrawal is on medical grounds. Such withdrawal is permitted up to, but not including, the first day of official practices for competition, subject to the provision of a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner.

<u>Medals:</u> Will be awarded to the first three places in each event. The <u>Loris Mills Cup for Ladies</u> will be awarded for the most outstanding skate.

<u>Ice Time:</u> The following ice time has been booked:

Sunday 1 October Practice & Competition: 7:00am - 12:00pm

Please note – these times may increase or decrease depending on entry numbers.

<u>Music:</u> Must be on CDs. All CDs <u>must</u> be clearly marked with the competitors name, club, grade, event, & length of music. Any CD in a broken case will not be accepted. The official competition CDs must be submitted at the skate hire counter at the Queenstown Ice Arena and placed in the appropriate marked box before skaters commence their official practices. Backup copies should be carried.

Photography: There is to be no flash photography as it may impact on the skater's performance.

Door Charges: Gold coin entry.
