Please note: Skaters must be members in good standing of a club affiliated to the NZIFSA or their country's governing body. Skater's competing in Pre Elementary and above must be TC registered with the NZIFSA.

Schedule: Where possible the event will take place over Saturday afternoon (June 2nd) and Sunday morning (June 3rd). Should additional time be required the Friday evening (June 1st) will be used, however this would only be for development grades.

Planned Program Content Sheets: Current PPC's are required to validate your entry. Please ensure your PPC is updated on NZIFSA website by close of entries.

Kiwiskate grades must submit a paper copy of PPCs with their entry.

Late entries: May be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Secretary. An additional fee of \$50.00 will be charged for entries accepted after the closing date, but no entries will be accepted after the draw under any circumstances. Refunds: Refund of entry fee(s) will be given until May 31st 2018 (inclusive), subject to the provision of a medical certificate.

Trophies (where applicable): Will be awarded to the highest placed DISC skater.

Technical Requirements & Eligibility: All disciplines and grades as per current NZIFSA Rules & Regulations for 2018 (ISU Junior & Senior 2018/2019 rules will apply). These are posted on the NZIFSA website www.nzifsa.org.nz Rules & Regulations, Competitions (200 sections).

Development Tier 1 Skills: Required Elements: Forward Edges, Waltz Jump, Inside 3 turns, Forward Spiral, Upright Spin (one or two foot)

Skaters entering this event will be in DISC Development Tier 1.

Development Tier 2 Skills: Required Elements: Russian Stroking, Backward Spiral, Shoot the Duck, Outside 3 Turns, Salchow Jump, Toe Loop Jump, Upright Spin (one foot)

Skaters entering this event will be in DISC Development Tier 2.

Development Tier 2 Free Skate: up to 1 minute 30 seconds. Required Elements: Step Sequence (1/2 rink), Upright Spin, Waltz Jump, Spiral, Drag, Salchow Jump.

Skaters entering this event will be in DISC Development Tier 2.

Music: Must be submitted as an MP3 to music4disc@gmail.com prior to close of entry. Music files must be named according to the following format:

FIRST-LAST-CATEGORY-SEGMENT.mp3

For example: Marin-Honda-Senior-Ladies-FreeSkate.mp3 or Jayne-Torville-Elementary-Dance-PatternDance.mp3

All competitors must have a backup music CD that is to be submitted upon registration at the event. CDs must be clearly marked with the competitors name, club, grade, event, & length of music.

Photography: No flash photography will be permitted as it may impact on the skater's performance.

Video Recording: Individuals using recording devices will be required to request the permission of the competition organisers prior to filming. Video permits will be available on competition days. Only people who have been granted a video permit may record only their own skater. If you wish to record other skaters then written permission must be obtained from the skater(s) concerned, if these skaters are minors, their parents or guardians must give written consent.

Seating: DISC encourages parents and spectators to show their support and encouragement from the stands and keep the marshalling area clear for skaters, volunteers and officials.

Volunteers: The success of the competition relies heavily on the availability of volunteers. DISC requests that parents/guardians of all DISC Member entrants assist with the success of this competition by indicating their availability for at least some of the time. Any offer of assistance is encouraged and welcome.

This competition is sanctioned by the NZIFSA.

The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all grades Kiwi Skate and above. Development grades will use an ordinal system where a Technical mark and an Artistic mark will be given.
