NON CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: KIWISKATE		
<b>Kiwiskaters do NOT require to be a member of the Dunedin Ice Skating Club</b>		
<b>Please enter the event of the badge you are working on</b>		
	Tiny Tots: (6yrs & Under)	Skate the width of the rink Backward marching Squat down while moving
	Beginner	Stop Backward skating Squat for 4 count
	Elementary	Forward bubbles T pushes Glide on one foot
	Basic	Forward pumping Two foot turn Four forward inside edges
	Novice 1	Backward glide Backward pumping Forward inside three turn (skater may choose which foot)
	Novice 2	Forward inside mowhawk (skater may choose which foot) Forward outside three turn (skater may choose which foot) Spiral on a curve
	Advanced	Backward outside edges Backward three turns (skater may choose inside or outside edges) Forward three turn into back outside edge
	Proficiency	Backward inside edges Backward crossovers Step sequence of skaters choice

NON CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: ARTISTIC FREESKATING		
<b>Skaters eligible to enter in this category include NoviceSkate AdvancedSkate TeenSkate and AdultSkate -</b>		
<b>Solo Freeskate</b>	5 – 8 years	A free skating programme up to 1 min 30 sec (+/- 10 secs)
	9 – 15 years	A free skating programme up to 1 min 30 sec (+/- 10 secs)
	16 – 25 years	A free skating programme up to 2 mins (+/- 10 secs)
	26 – 45 years	A free skating programme up to 2 mins (+/- 10 secs)
	46 years +	A free skating programme up to 2 mins (+/- 10 secs)

<b>Partner Dance</b>	Bronze	Dutch Waltz, Canasta Tango, Baby Blues ( <i>Select any two</i> )
	Silver	Fiesta Tango, Rhythm Blues, Riverside Rumba ( <i>Select any two</i> )
	Gold	Foxtrot, Fourteen Step
<b>Verhoef Waltzing Trophy</b>		European Waltz ( <i>Must be danced as a male and female couple</i> )
<b>Solo Dance</b>	Bronze	Dutch Waltz, Canasta Tango, Baby Blues ( <i>Select any two</i> )
	Silver	Fiesta Tango, Rhythm Blues, Riverside Rumba ( <i>Select any two</i> )
	Gold	Foxtrot, Fourteen Step

NON CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: SYNCHRONISED		
<b>Synchronised Skills</b>	Beginner	Team of minimum 6 skaters. Programme up to 2 mins (+/- 10 secs)
<b>Adult</b>		A team of 9 – 16 skaters. No test passes necessary

<b>NON CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: TEAM – SPIN/SPIRAL/JUMP/FOOTWORK COMPETITION</b>		
<b>Age Groups</b>	5 – 11 years	Teams of 4 skaters: Each team member must perform one of the required elements. Spin, spiral, jump, footwork. In each age group the team with the highest score wins

<b>NON CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: ARTISTIC – THEATRE ON ICE/ INTERPRETATIVE</b>		
<b>Age Groups</b>	5 – 11 years	Must have at least two, and no more than four skaters. Vocal music is allowed. Props are allowed, but must not be left on the ice. Programme up to 2 mins (+/- 10 secs)

<b>CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: FREESKATING</b>		
<p>Skaters are required to hold a 2012 T/C registration. Requirements for the following grades will be the same as the 2012 NZIFSA Rules &amp; Regulations. Please read the rules &amp; regulations and discuss with your coach.</p> <p><i>Note: Rule 205.1 Skaters must compete in local club or regional championship, not a competition in order to be eligible to compete at the NZIFSA National Championships.</i></p>		
<b>Freeskating</b>  <b>Where applicable skaters will skate their long programme (Freeskate) only</b>	<b>Grade</b>	<b>Test requirements Rule 227.1 applies</b>
	Beginner	Must not have competed in Beginners or any competitive level previously. Depending on numbers, this grade may be divided into groups: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Under 10</li> <li>• 10 and Over</li> </ul>
	Pre-Elementary	May not hold any NZISA Freeskating medals but may hold Preliminary Stroking but no higher.
	Elementary	Must hold a minimum of Elementary Freeskate & Elementary Stroking.
	Juvenile	Must hold a minimum of Preliminary Freeskate & Preliminary Stroking. Must not have reached the age of 18 before 1 <sup>st</sup> July.
	Pre-primary	Must hold a minimum of Interbronze Freeskate & Interbronze Stroking
	Primary	Must hold a minimum of Bronze Freeskate & Bronze Stroking. Must not have reached the age of 14 before 1 <sup>st</sup> July.
	Intermediate	Must hold a minimum of Bronze Freeskate & Bronze Stroking.
	Novice	Must hold a minimum of Intersilver Freeskate & Intersilver Stroking or passed Novice Competitive test.
	Junior	Must hold a minimum of Silver Freeskate & Silver Stroking or passed Junior Competitive test
	Senior	Must hold a minimum of Intergold Freeskate & Intergold Stroking or passed Senior Competitive test.

<b>CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: DANCE</b>		
<p>Skaters are required to hold a 2012 T/C registration. Requirements for the following grades will be the same as the 2012 NZIFSA Rules &amp; Regulations. Please read the rules &amp; regulations and discuss with your coach.</p>		
<b>Partner Dance</b>	Pre-Elementary	Skaters must not hold any NZIFSA Dance medals Dutch Waltz, Canasta Tango (Both to be skated)
	Elementary	Skaters must hold Elementary NZIFSA Dance medal. Compulsory dances: Canasta Tango, Golden Skater's Waltz (Both to be skated)
	Juvenile	Skaters will select one dance from the Compulsory dances as per Rule 231.1 for the 2012 year. Skaters will also skate Free Dance as per Rule 231.2

<b>Solo Dance</b>	Pre-Elementary	Skaters must not hold any NZIFSA Dance medals Dutch Waltz, Canasta Tango (Both to be skated)
	Elementary	Both Skaters must hold Elementary NZIFSA Dance medals.

<b>Solo Dance cont...</b>		Canasta Tango, Golden Skater's Waltz
	Juvenile	Skaters must hold Preliminary NZIFSA Dance medal Riverside Rhumba, Swing Dance
	Pre-primary	Skaters must hold Preliminary Compulsory Dance. Willow Waltz, Foxtrot
	Primary	Skaters must hold Bronze Compulsory Dance. American Waltz, Fourteenstep (skated as a pattern dance only)
	Open	Skaters must hold Intersilver Compulsory Dance. Rocker Foxtrot, Starlight Waltz (one Pattern Dance selected and one Short Dance in accordance to NZIFSA requirements)

### CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: SYNCHRONISED

**Skaters are required to hold a 2012 T/C registration. Requirements for the following grades will be the same as the 2012 NZISA Rules & Regulations. Please read the rules & regulations and discuss with your coach.**

Open	A team of 9 – 16 skaters. Must have passed a minimum of Elementary Stroking or Elementary Dance. No age limits
Junior	A team of 12-16 skaters. All skaters must have passed a minimum of Inter-Bronze Stroking or Inter-Bronze Dance. Age limits apply.
Senior	A team of 12 – 16 skaters. Must have passed a minimum of Inter-Bronze Stroking or Inter-Bronze Dance. Age limits apply.

### CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: ADULT

**Skaters are required to hold a 2012 T/C registration. Requirements for the following grades will be the same as the 2012 NZIFSA Rules & Regulations. Please read the rules & regulations and discuss with your coach.**

Pre-Primary	Minimum test passes – Inter-Bronze Pairs and Inter-Bronze Stroking
Primary	Minimum test passes – Bronze Pairs and Bronze Stroking
