At all competitions, competitors in every event to be scored using the IJS must submit for each program their planned program content (PPC) information (including musical selection) no later than **two weeks** prior to the respective competition. Competitors must complete either the electronic form on the NZISA website or submit a paper copy. Changed PPC sheets must be handed in to the Accreditation desk at the time of registration for the information of the Technical Panel. **Entries will not be accepted without a completed PPC, either hard copy or electronic.**

****DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME****
