Venue: Queenstown Ice Arena, Park Street, Queenstown

This 5th annual event, hosted by the Queenstown Ice Skating Club, aims to be a quality event that will provide the best available practice & competition times for competitors.

Entry Fees Singles:

\$ 70.00	Development 1 & Development 2
\$ 90.00	Beginner, Pre-Elementary, Elementary, Juvenile, Pre-Primary, Primary, Intermediate & Adult
\$150.00	Novice, Junior & Senior

Cost of official practices is included in the entry fee

Beginner & Juvenile grades may be divided by age if required, depending on the number of entries received. If necessary, numbers may be limited due to ice time availability. The above will be at the discretion of the organisers.

Closing Date: Tuesday 4 June 2013

(Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the competition co-ordinator, an additional fee of \$50.00 will be charged for entries accepted after the closing date).

No refund of entry fee/s will be given after the draw.

Trophies: Will be awarded to the first three places in each event regardless of the club or country that they represent. The **Loris Mills Cup for Ladies** for most outstanding skate will be awarded for the 4th time.

Ice Time: To assist you with your travel arrangement the following ice time has been booked:

Sunday 16 June Practice & Competition: 6:30am-1:30pm

Please note – these times may increase or decrease depending on entry numbers.

Music: Must be on CDs. All CDs must be clearly marked with the competitors name, club, grade, event, & length of music. The official competition CDs must be submitted at the skate hire counter at the Queenstown Ice Arena and placed in the appropriate marked box before skaters commence their official practices. Backup copies should be carried.

Draws: IJS electronic random selection Saturday 8 June.

Photography: There is to be no flash photography as it may impact on the skater's performance.

Video Recording: Individuals using video cameras will be required to register at the accreditation desk on the day of the event. A video pass will be issued at no charge. Only people who have a video permit may video and only their own skater. If you wish to video other skaters then written permission must be obtained from the skater/s concerned, or in the case of minors, their parents or guardians. Videoing can only be done in the designated area.

NO VIDEOING OF PRACTICE SESSIONS IS ALLOWED
