### **Draws**

The draws will be done using the IJS computer system. Clubs will be advised once this has been done and the starting orders will be posted on the NZIFSA website (<a href="https://www.nzifsa.org.nz/competitions/">https://www.nzifsa.org.nz/competitions/</a>) as soon as they are available.

#### Music

For entries to be accepted skaters need to have submitted their music in mp3 format already to <a href="mailto:music4siissa@gmail.com">music4siissa@gmail.com</a>. All competitors must bring a back up of their music on a labeled USB stick. This will not be collected but the competitor's coach must know where it is in the event there is an issue on the day.

#### Video

Competitors may be videoed using any type of device but the person taking the video must have a permit and video from the area set aside for this.

Lights on tablets, phones or camera's must be switched off so competitors and officials are not distracted.

**Photography** Flashes must not be used during the competition.


**Gifts** Gifts for competitors, such as flowers and sweets, must not be thrown on the ice.



# **Rink Layout**



**Skating on Public Sessions** Skaters can skate on public sessions. NZIFSA Rule 213.5 relating to practice sessions after the Championships have begun only relates to the National Championships and Adult National Championships. However, skaters need to be aware that jumping and spinning is not permitted on public sessions.

Getting to and from the rink Alpine Ice Sport Centre is at 495 Brougham Street, Opawa, Christchurch. Brougham Street has two lanes each way, divided by a median island. The rink is on your left if you are heading east along Brougham Street. When you exit the rink, if you want to return along Brougham Street, turn left out of the rink (it's one way so you need to turn left anyway), then right at the traffic lights, right again (third exit) at the first round about, then a left turn at the next lights will have you back on Brougham Street heading west.
