EVENTS, ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS: SINGLES:

Development

Programme up to 1 minute 40 seconds
Skaters may not hold any NZIFSA Free skating or stroking tests.
Bunny Hop, One Foot Spin (min 2 revs), Waltz jump, Toe Loop, Backward pivot, Basic Step sequence (1/3 length of rink minimum), Spiral sequence (minimum 2 spirals)

The IJS will NOT be used for this grade, placing will be determined by majority opinion of the judges.

Kiwiskate, Pre Elementary, Elementary
Juvenile to Intermediate Novice

As per NZIFSA Rule 226.3
As per NZIFSA Rule 224.1 & 226.2

These grades shall be divided into three categories according to the skater's age as at the 1st July immediately preceding the championship: Under 12, Ladies (12 & Over) and Men (12 & Over).

Adult
Youth Interpretive

As per NZIFSA Rule 224.2, 226.5 & 226.6
As per NZIFSA Rule 224.1 & 226.4

Note: Athletes MUST have the required tests for the grade they are entering at the close of entries.

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

The AISC Club Championships will be conducted in accordance with the NZIFSA Rules and Regulations for 2022. These are posted on the NZIFSA website <http://www.nzifsa.org.nz/rules/competitions>

VIDEO RECORDING AND PHOTOGRAPHY:

The AISC retains the rights for any video recording of the Championships. Individuals using video devices will be required to request the permission of the competition organisers prior to the competition. A video permit will be issued. Only people who have a video permit may record their own skater. If you wish to record other skaters then written permission must be obtained from the skater(s) concerned, or in the case of minors, their parents or guardians. Otherwise, video recording is prohibited. The use of FLASH photographs or VIDEO- LIGHTS is not permitted during warm-ups or events
