Less than two weeks until the 2023 New Zealand Ice Figure Skating Championships (Nationals) at Dunedin Ice Stadium, Saturday 7 - Tuesday 10 October 2023! Here is some updated information from DISC to assist you with your planning.

UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE ICE

You are able to book one session of unofficial ice per skater, or per synchro team, on the booking form below:

- Unofficial ice session for singles and couples will be 30 mins (\$15 per skater)
- Unofficial ice sessions for synchro teams will be 20 mins (\$120 per team)

Initial bookings are due by 5pm Saturday 30 September. If spaces remain after the initial bookings are allocated, we will open a form for Bookings #2. At this point, you will be able to book a second slot of unofficial ice. We thank you for your patience.
