# ISU DEVELOPMENT TROPHY, KUALA LUMPUR, 6-11 APRIL

The ISU have committed to holding the World Development Trophy again this year and next. Unfortunately the details of this year's trophy have come to us very late in the piece, and clash with the NZIFSA Development Camp in Queenstown. The late notice means that we have only one skater attending this year — Brooke Tamepo in Junior Ladies. Rosie Armstrong will be attending as the Coach- Team Leader. The ISU have also invited New Zealand to send an International/ISU Judge and Sue Petricevic has accepted this invitation.

The 2015 ISU World Development Trophy is being organized by the Ice Skating Association of Malaysia. The event will include an international competition (6 April, 2015) followed by an international training camp (7-11 April 2015) with Ms. Shanetta Folle as moderator.

Skaters who have been to this event in previous years have all found the experience really valuable, and I have no doubt Brooke will get a lot out of this opportunity.

## **UPCOMING COACHING COURSES FOR 2015**

A successful level 1 Coaching course was held in Auckland, March 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>. We are not planning to run another Level 1 coaching course until next year.

One further **Introduction to Coaching Course** is planned this year. It will be held in Christchurch, April 17th & 18th. The course will start Friday afternoon and finish Saturday midday. Registration forms and payment were due by 28 February 2015, but late entries may be accepted. A late payment fee may apply.

A Level 2 course is still in the works and more details will be sent out as soon as we have them from the Australian Professional Skaters Association. It is expected that there will be a series of modules to be completed, with a seminar held after the 2015 Australian Figure Skating Champs.
